





NOTICE OF RACE Open Dutch Championship Olympia-Jol class organized by ZV Belterwiede under the auspices of the RNWA September 30th & October 1st 2023 location: Beulaker Wiede, Wanneperveen

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- **1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at <u>https://www.sailing.org/inside-world-sailing/rules-regulations/racing-rules-of-sailing/</u>
- **1.2** The 'Rules for (Open) Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' (available at reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf (watersportverbond.nl) will apply.
- **1.3** Changes of the racing rules will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules as well.
- **1.4** If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- **1.5** Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

- **4.1** The event is open to all boats of the Olympiajol class.
- **4.2** Boats may enter the event by registering and Paying online before 23rd of September 2023 at olympiajol.nl. Please state class and sail number.
- **4.3** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

- 10.2 [DP] Boats already measured and registered on the Open Dutch Championship organized on 1 to 3 September 2023 will not be measured again. Additional registrations shall be available for equipment inspection on 30th of September from 8:30 to 10:00 hrs.







- 10.3 The following equipment will be inspected : Life Jacket
- **10.4** Boats may be inspected at any time, also on the water.
- **10.5** [DP] Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 when presented for inspection.

- **15.1** Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- **15.2** (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15.3 RRS 90.3(e) applies.

21 DATA PROTECTION

21.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- **22.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- **22.2** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

23 INSURANCE

23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

24 PRIZES

24.1 The RNWA supplies for the winning boat or team a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats or crews (there will be no extra medals available for changes in the crew during the event).


