



Equipment Inspection EURO 2026

In accordance with Rule 78.1 of the Racing Rules of Sailing, your Olympiajolle must at all times comply with the current class rules in order to participate in races. To ensure a level playing field and fair competition at EURO 2026, and thereby ensure that the best sailor wins, a number of checks will be carried out during the equipment inspection prior to the race series to verify that your boat complies with the current class rules.

Time Slot

To ensure that the equipment inspection runs smoothly and efficiently, you will be assigned a specific time slot. You must report your presence to one of the equipment inspectors at least 15 minutes before the start of your allocated time slot.

Inspection During the Regatta

Your boat must continue to comply with the class rules throughout the event. Therefore, you may also be selected for an equipment inspection during the regatta, after completion of the racing on a given day.

Competitors should note that any non-conformities identified during earlier equipment inspections have been rectified before arrival at EURO 2026. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure continued compliance with the class rules throughout the event.

Self-Inspection

To help ensure that you can fully enjoy EURO 2026 and that the equipment inspection remains a mere formality, we encourage you to check the inspection points yourself in advance at home. Please use the leaflet 'EURO 2026 Point for inspection' for this purpose. If you have any questions or doubts about compliance, do not wait until EURO 2026.
